

It's a good book, but I HIGHLY encourage users NOT to get the e-book. It's so poorly formatted and I'm filled with regret that I didn't just get the hard copy. There are no page numbers, only locations,

so it's nearly impossible to figure out where you are in the book or to navigate around to different sections. You have to go back to the table of contents each time you want to go to a new section (there's not even a side bar!). Not user friendly in the slightest.
