

I first purchased Rohde's guide for the Technician Class license, and found it so quick and simple that I bought this book, studied it, and passed both exams on the same day. The book's study process is straightforward and effective, and as the author points out, your time is better spent by getting licensed and learning through experience than it is by poring through chapter after chapter on theory. The book has 100% of the General Class exam questions, in exactly the way they are worded on the exam, with the exact answers that you will see on the exam. Do as the author suggests, and first study the questions with the right AND wrong answers listed. After all, seeing only the right answer is not very helpful when that answer is, "All of these answers are correct." Once reasonably proficient, you can then move on to studying the questions with only the right answers listed. This is similar to using flash cards. The process is quick and effective. I'm not an excellent test taker, but I passed both exams on my first try, missing one question on each. I spent probably 4 days on each book beforehand.

All that the Kindle version contains (following some general words of advice) is two listings of the question pool for the exam. One is the complete listing as randomly extracted and presented to the person taking the exam, but with the correct answer identified. This listing is freely available online at [...]. The other listing is the same except that the incorrect answers have been eliminated. Further, there is no table of contents to take you directly to the pared down second listing.

I would recommend this very highly. I have passed one test and am working on my next one. It is very complete and easy to study. I have this on Kindle and take it every where. With out this I don't think I could have passed at all. Has very good tips. It is excellent.

This is worthless. To call something a study that is basically just two listings of the test questions is preposterous. A lot of talk up in the intro chapters do nothing to prepare you for a test. They explain only what amateur radio is and why you need a license. There is no substantive material here that will truly help you get your license, that you can't get in better more interactive formats elsewhere. This book was a waste of my time.
